**JUNIOR CAMP VISITATION POLICY**

Guests are a wonderful part of camp. However there will be a charge for all those who choose to visit the camp and enjoy the activities. Meals are available for a fee. Please see Bro. Mitchell if you intend on eating at the camp and are not a registered camper. Evening service is open to everyone without a fee.

**JUNIOR CAMP SCHEDULE**

Registration begins at 12 Noon on Monday, July 8, 2019  
Staff and Camper orientation begin at 3:30 PM.  
All camper and staff must vacate the campgrounds by 9 AM on Friday, July 12, 2019. A complete schedule will be available at registration.

**MEDICAL INFORMATION**

Please fill out the medical information completely on the registration form. If your young person is bringing any type of medication (prescription or over the counter) it must be turned in at the registration desk with very specific instruction for the Camp Nurse. Please put all medication in once labeled Zip-Loc bag.

**LODGING**

Lodging is provided with camp tuition. However, the cost to repair, replace and clean dorms left in an unsatisfactory condition is not. **We are using a leased facility that has been graciously offered to us, so please respect all regulations posted by the host establishment.** Destruction of dorms and/or property will not be tolerated, and camper(s) will be dismissed immediately from the premises for violation of this policy **Note: if you are not staying on camp grounds please let us know at registration.**

**AGE**

**Campers must be at least 6 years old and cannot be more than 12 years old.**

Younger children may register as guests provided an adult will supervise them throughout the camp. Camp staff will not be responsible for children under 6 years old.

- All workers must be at least 18 years old.
- All Workers under 18 must have their Parent and Pastor's written approval.

**DRESS AND CONDUCT FOR EVERYONE**

Kansas District Junior Camp provides a safe and fun place where children can connect with Jesus Christ. All campers are expected to maintain a conduct of Christ like character. Therefore, standards of dress, conduct and disciplines are an important guideline for attending this camp.

**APPEARANCE**

**Young Men**

No Facial Hair  
Hair must be off of collar and ear.

**Young Ladies**

Hem lines should cover the knees at all times  
Splits must be below the bend of the knee.  
No cosmetic makeup of any kind including: all types nail polish, lipstick, foundation or lip gloss.

**Both Young Men and Ladies**

No jewelry  
No tight-fitting or see-through clothing  
Dresses/blouses/ shirts must have a minimum of short sleeves or longer **NO SLEEVELESS OR CAP SLEEVE TOPS!!!**  
No revealing necklines.  
NO clothing should be worn that displays vulgar, distasteful or suggestive logos or writing.  
Shorts are not allowed.

**CONDUCT**

Boys must stay away from the girl's dorms and girls must stay away from the boy's dorms.

No physical display of affection will be allowed.

Doors within the dorms should remain unlocked at all times. Campers must remain with their assigned groups. Under no circumstance are campers allowed to go anywhere unsupervised.

Room assignments will not be made unless first cleared by **camp director**.

Campers may not leave the campground unless permission has been given by the **camp director**.

Campers must follow the camp schedule.

Campers should not bring any electronic devices, with the exception of **cell phone for emergencies**.
